ESV	In a multitude of people is the glory of a king, but without people a prince is ruined.
NIV	A large population is a king's glory, but without subjects a prince is ruined.
NLT	A growing population is a king's glory; a prince without subjects has nothing.
LXX	ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. πολλῶ ἔθνει δόξα βασιλέως ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. δὲplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐκλείπει λαοῦ συντριβὴ δυνάστου
