	יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. ESV	The LORD tears down the house of the proud but maintains the widow's boundaries.
NIV	The LORD tears down the proud man's house but he keeps the widow's boundaries intact.
NLT	The LORD tears down the house of the proud, but he protects the property of widows.

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ὅριον χήρας
