	רוּחַ שְׂבִיב חַיִּים וְסֵלָה hebrew Meaning: * Wind * Breath * Spirit Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament. Though usually feminine, רוּחַ sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה).Exodus 10:13Genesis 6:17Genesis 41:8Proverbs 16:32Ecclesiastes 12:7Genesis 1:2Judges 3:10Ezekiel 36:27Genesis 2:7John 3:8Genesis 1:2Genesis 8:1
ESV	A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit.
NIV	The tongue that brings healing is a tree of life, but a deceitful tongue crushes the spirit.
NLT	Gentle words are a tree of life; a deceitful tongue crushes the spirit.

LXX	greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. συντηρῶν αὐτὴν αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
