Hebrew	שָׁמַר Meaning: * To guard * To protect * To keep * To observe * To attend The verb שמר occurs about 470 times in the Old Testament. Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalm 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalm 127:1Luke 2:19 תִּכְחַת יַעֲרֹם
	ESV A fool despises his father's instruction, but whoever heeds reproof is prudent.
	NIV A fool spurns his father's discipline, but whoever heeds correction shows prudence.
	NLT Only a fool despises a parent's discipline; whoever learns from correction is wise.

Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. φυλάσσω ἐντολὰς πανουργότερος
	KJV A fool despiseth his father's instruction: but he that regardeth reproof is prudent.
