	יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name Hebrew It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. δικαιοσύνην ἀγαπᾷ
