ESV	How much better to get wisdom than gold! To get understanding is to be chosen rather than silver.
NIV	How much better to get wisdom than gold, to choose understanding rather than silver!
NLT	How much better to get wisdom than gold, and good judgment than silver!
LXX	νοσσιαὶ σοφίας αἰρετώτεραι χρυσίου νοσσιαὶ δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. φρονήσεως αἰρετώτεραι ὑπὲρ ἀργύριον
