Hebrew	רוּחַ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big רוח hebrew Meaning: * Wind * Breath * Spirit Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament. Though usually feminine, רוח sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה). ESV	Whoever restrains his words has knowledge, and he who has a cool spirit is a man of understanding.
NIV	A man of knowledge uses words with restraint, and a man of understanding is even-tempered.
NLT	A truly wise person uses few words; a person with understanding is even-tempered.
LXX	ὅς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big ὅς, ἥ, ὃ greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning φείδεται ῥῆμα πρόσθαι σκληρόν ἐπιγνώμων μακρόθυμος δέ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἀνήρ φρόνιμος
KJV	He that hath knowledge spareth his words: and a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit.

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
