Hebrew	עֲטָרַת זָקִינִים בְּנֵי בָנִים וְתִפְאֶרֶת בָּנִים אֲבוֹתָם
ESV	Grandchildren are the crown of the aged, and the glory of children is their fathers.
NIV	Children's children are a crown to the aged, and parents are the pride of their children.
NLT	Grandchildren are the crowning glory of the aged; parents are the pride of their children.
LXX	στέφανος γερόντων τέκνα τέκνων καύχημα δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. τέκνων πατέρες αὐτῶν greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
