ESV	A rich man's wealth is his strong city, and like a high wall in his imagination.
NIV	The wealth of the rich is their fortified city; they imagine it an unscalable wall.
NLT	The rich think of their wealth as a strong defense; they imagine it to be a high wall of safety.

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. δόξα αὐτῆς αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) μέγα ἐπισκιάζει
