

Proverbs 18:17

Hebrew	צִדִּיק הָרִאשׁוֹן בְּרִיגָו יבֹא וְכֹא רֵעֵהוּ וְחִקְרוּ
ESV	The one who states his case first seems right, until the other comes and examines him.
NIV	The first to present his case seems right, till another comes forward and questions him.
NLT	The first to speak in court sounds right- until the cross-examination begins.
LXX	δίκαιος ἑαυτοῦ κατήγορος ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. πρωτολογίᾳ ὥς δ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἂν ἐπιβάλῃ ὁ greek The definite article ἀντίδικος ἐλέγχεται
KJV	He that is first in his own cause seemeth just; but his neighbour cometh and searcheth him.
