ESV	Wealth brings many new friends, but a poor man is deserted by his friend.
NIV	Wealth brings many friends, but a poor man's friend deserts him.
NLT	Wealth makes many “friends”; poverty drives them all away.

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. πτωχὸς καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀπὸ τοῦ greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ ὑπάρχοντος φίλου λείπεται
