

Proverbs 19:5

Hebrew	עַד שֶׁקָרִים לֹא יִנָּקָה וַיִּפֹּת לֹא יִמָּלֵט
ESV	A false witness will not go unpunished, and he who breathes out lies will not escape.
NIV	A false witness will not go unpunished, and he who pours out lies will not go free.
NLT	A false witness will not go unpunished, nor will a liar escape.
LXX	μάρτυς ψευδῆς οὐκ ἀτιμώρητος ἔσται greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὁ greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐγκαλῶν ἀδίκως οὐ διαφεύξεται
KJV	A false witness shall not be unpunished, and he that speaketh lies shall not escape.

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
