NIV	Many curry favor with a ruler, and everyone is the friend of a man who gives gifts.
NLT	Many seek favors from a ruler; everyone is the friend of a person who gives gifts!
LXX	πολλοὶ θεραπεύουσιν πρόσωπα βασιλέων πᾶς greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians 1:16 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ὁ greek The definite article κακὸς γίνεται ὄνειδος ἀνδρί
