Central in covenant language. God “keeps” His covenant promises, and His people are called to Deuteronomy 7:9Psalm 121:7Deuteronomy 7:11Psalm 127:1Luke 2:19
	ESV guarding the paths of justice and watching over the way of his saints.
	NIV for he guards the course of the just and protects the way of his faithful ones.
	NLT He guards the paths of the just and protects those who are faithful to him.

IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὁδὸν εὐλαβουμένων αὐτὸν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
