	Meaning
	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word הִנָּהּ (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.
	First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. Exodus 3:14 Deuteronomy 6:4 Psalm 23:1 Romans 10:13 Joel 2:32 Exodus 20:7 Psalm 18:1 Exodus 15:3 Psalm 8:1 Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3 Judges 6:24 Genesis 22:14 Jeremiah 23:6 עֲשֵׂה גַם שְׁנֵיהֶם
ESV	The hearing ear and the seeing eye, the LORD has made them both.
NIV	Ears that hear and eyes that see- the LORD has made them both.
NLT	Ears to hear and eyes to see- both are gifts from the LORD.

KJV	* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So
	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀμφοτέρω
KJV	The hearing ear, and the seeing eye, the LORD hath made even both of them.

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
