

Proverbs 20:26

Hebrew	מִזְרָה רְשָׁעִים מִלֶּךְ חָכָם וַיִּשָּׁב עֲלֵיהֶם אוֹרֶן
ESV	A wise king winnows the wicked and drives the wheel over them.
NIV	A wise king winnows out the wicked; he drives the threshing wheel over them.
NLT	A wise king scatters the wicked like wheat, then runs his threshing wheel over them.
LXX	λικμήτωρ ἀσεβῶν βασιλεὺς σοφὸς καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐπιβαλεῖ αὐτοῖς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) τροχόν
KJV	A wise king scattereth the wicked, and bringeth the wheel over them.

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
