

Proverbs 20:4

Hebrew	מְחַרֵּץ עֲצֵל לֹא יַחְרֹשׁ יִשְׁאֵל וְשָׂאֵל בְּקֶצֶיר וְאֵין
ESV	The sluggard does not plow in the autumn; he will seek at harvest and have nothing.
NIV	A sluggard does not plow in season; so at harvest time he looks but finds nothing.
NLT	Those too lazy to plow in the right season will have no food at the harvest.
LXX	ὁνειδιζόμενος ὀκνηρὸς οὐκ αἰσχύνεται ὥσαύτως καὶ αὐτὸς αἰσχύνηται greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὁ greek The definite article δανιζόμενος σῖτον ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἀμήτω
KJV	The sluggard will not plow by reason of the cold; therefore shall he beg in harvest, and have nothing.
