ESV	When a scoffer is punished, the simple becomes wise; when a wise man is instructed, he gains knowledge.
NIV	When a mocker is punished, the simple gain wisdom; when a wise man is instructed, he gets knowledge.
NLT	If you punish a mocker, the simpleminded become wise; if you instruct the wise, they will be all the wiser.

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. σοφὸς δέξεται γνῶσιν
