ESV	A wise man scales the city of the mighty and brings down the stronghold in which they trust.
NIV	A wise man attacks the city of the mighty and pulls down the stronghold in which they trust.
NLT	The wise conquer the city of the strong and level the fortress in which they trust.

LXX	<p>greek</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* Who * Which * What</p> <p>The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).</p> <p>It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἐπεποίθεισαν οἱ ὄ, ἢ, τό</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* The</p> <p>The definite article.</p> <p>Forms</p> <p>Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ ἀσεβεῖς</p>
