ESV	“Scoffer” is the name of the arrogant, haughty man who acts with arrogant pride.
NIV	The proud and arrogant man-“Mocker” is his name; he behaves with overweening pride.
NLT	Mockers are proud and haughty; they act with boundless arrogance.
LXX	ῥασὺς καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀλαζῶν λοιμὸς καλεῖται ὅς greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι (“that,” introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning δὲ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. μνησικακεῖ παράνομος
KJV	Proud and haughty scorner is his name, who dealeth in proud wrath.
