ESV	All day long he craves and craves, but the righteous gives and does not hold back.
NIV	All day long he craves for more, but the righteous give without sparing.
NLT	Some people are always greedy for more, but the godly love to give!
LXX	ἀσεβὴς ἐπιθυμεῖ ὅλην τὴν greek The definite article ἡμέραν ἐπιθυμίας κακὰς ὁ greek The definite article δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. δίκαιος ἔλε᾽ καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” οἰκτίρει ἀφειδῶς
KJV	He coveteth greedily all the day long: but the righteous giveth and spareth not.

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
