Hebrew	Meaning * To be firm * Establish * Prepare * Set Verb. Occurs about 200 times in the Old Testament. Meanings by Stem Qal Stem (basic form) To be firm, stable, fixed, established. Describes something that stands securely or endures.Psalm 93:2Psalm 103:19Proverbs 16:9Psalm 96:102 Samuel 7:16Proverbs 16:3Luke 22:321 Peter 5:101 Corinthians 1:8Hebrews 2:3Colossians 1:23Matthew 25:34 יחדיו על שפתיה
ESV	for it will be pleasant if you keep them within you, if all of them are ready on your lips.
NIV	for it is pleasing when you keep them in your heart and have all of them ready on your lips.

Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
