ESV	The father of the righteous will greatly rejoice; he who fathers a wise son will be glad in him.
NIV	The father of a righteous man has great joy; he who has a wise son delights in him.
NLT	The father of godly children has cause for joy. What a pleasure to have children who are wise.
LXX	καλῶς ἐκτρέφει πατήρ δίκαιος ἐπὶ δέ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. υἱὸ σοφῷ εὐφραίνεται ἡ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek The definite article ψυχὴ αὐτοῦ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
