Hebrew	רוּחַ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big אין חֹמֶה אִישׁ אֲשֶׁר אֵין מַעְצָר לְרוּחוֹ hebrew Meaning: * Wind * Breath * Spirit Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament. Though usually feminine, רוּחַ sometimes takes masculine verbs and adjectives, especially when referring to the Spirit of God (רוּחַ יְהוָה).
