	ברך plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigברך Meaning * To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament. The word ברך marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28 Psalm 103:1 Numbers 6:24 לו רעהו בקול גדול בבקר השמים קללה תחשב לו
Hebrew	
ESV	Whoever blesses his neighbor with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, will be counted as cursing.
NIV	If a man loudly blesses his neighbor early in the morning, it will be taken as a curse.
NLT	A loud and cheerful greeting early in the morning will be taken as a curse!

KJV	He that blesseth his friend with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, it shall be counted a curse to him.

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
