ESV	Blessed is the one who finds wisdom, and the one who gets understanding,
NIV	Blessed is the man who finds wisdom, the man who gains understanding,
NLT	Joyful is the person who finds wisdom, the one who gains understanding.
LXX	μακάριος ἄνθρωπος ὃς greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning εὗρεν σοφίαν καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" θνητὸς ὃς greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).
