Hebrew	בְּדַעְתּוֹ תְּהוֹמוֹת נִבְקְעוּ וְשָׁחֲקִים יִרְעֲפוּ טל
ESV	by his knowledge the deeps broke open, and the clouds drop down the dew.
NIV	by his knowledge the deeps were divided, and the clouds let drop the dew.
NLT	By his knowledge the deep fountains of the earth burst forth, and the dew settles beneath the night sky.
LXX	ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. αἰσθήσει ἄβυσσοι ἐρράγησαν νέφη δὲplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐρρήσαν δρόσους
