Usage in the New Testament The sense of παῖς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. LXX	greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἵνα ὁρθοτομή τὰςplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article ὁδοὺς σου ὁplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article δέplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. πούς σου οὐ μὴ προσκόπτῃ
