Hebrew	אַל תִּלְשֹׁן עֶבֶד אֶל אֲדֹנָיו כִּי יְקַלֵּךְ וְאַשְׁמָתְךָ
ESV	Do not slander a servant to his master, lest he curse you and you be held guilty.
NIV	“Do not slander a servant to his master, or he will curse you, and you will pay for it.
NLT	Never slander a worker to the employer, or the person will curse you, and you will pay for it.
LXX	μὴ παραδῶς οἰκέτην εἰς χεῖρας δεσπότου μήποτε καταράσῃταί σε καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀφανισθῆς
KJV	Accuse not a servant unto his master, lest he curse thee, and thou be found guilty.
