ESV	This is the way of an adulteress: she eats and wipes her mouth and says, "I have done no wrong."
NIV	"This is the way of an adulteress: She eats and wipes her mouth and says, 'I've done nothing wrong.'
NLT	An adulterous woman consumes a man, then wipes her mouth and says, "What's wrong with that?"
LXX	τοιαύτη ὁδὸς γυναικὸς μοιχαλίδος ἥplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὅς, ἦ, ὅ greek Meaning: * Who * Which * What The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent). It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ὅταν πράξη ἀπονισαμένη οὐδέν φησιν πεπραχέναι ἄτοπον
KJV	Such is the way of an adulterous woman; she eateth, and wipeth her mouth, and saith, I have done no wickedness.

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
