ESV	a slave when he becomes king, and a fool when he is filled with food;
NIV	a servant who becomes king, a fool who is full of food,
NLT	a slave who becomes a king, an overbearing fool who prospers,
LXX	ἐὰν οἰκέτης βασιλεύσῃ καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἄφρων πλησθῆ σιτίων
