ESV	the lizard you can take in your hands, yet it is in kings' palaces.
NIV	a lizard can be caught with the hand, yet it is found in kings' palaces.
NLT	Lizards- they are easy to catch, but they are found even in kings' palaces.
LXX	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” καλαβώτης χερσὶν ἐρειδόμενος καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” εὐάλωτος ὦν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. κατοικεῖ ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. ὀχυρώμασιν βασιλέως
