It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. βύσσου καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πορφύρας ἑαυτῇ ἐνδύματα
