Hebrew	יְהוָה יִרְאֶה אֶשְׁכָּר הַחַר וְהַבֶּל הַלְפִי אֶשְׁכָּר יִרְאֶה יְהוָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. ESV	Charm is deceitful, and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised.

LXX	ψευδεῖς ἀρέσκειαι καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” μάταιον κάλλος γυναικός γυνή γὰρ συνετή εὐλογεῖται φόβον δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. κυρίου αὕτη greek Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 αἰνέτω
