ESV	Open your mouth, judge righteously, defend the rights of the poor and needy.
NIV	Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy.” Epilogue: The Wife of Noble Character
NLT	Yes, speak up for the poor and helpless, and see that they get justice.
LXX	ἀνοιγε σὸν στόμα καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” κρῖνε δικάως διάκρινε δέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. πένητα καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἄσθενῃ
KJV	Open thy mouth, judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy.

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
