Hebrew	וְלֹא שָׁמַעְתִּי בְּקוֹל מוֹרֵי וְלֹא הִטֵּייתִי אָזְנִי
ESV	I did not listen to the voice of my teachers or incline my ear to my instructors.
NIV	I would not obey my teachers or listen to my instructors.
NLT	Oh, why didn't I listen to my teachers? Why didn't I pay attention to my instructors?
LXX	οὐκ ἤκουον φωνὴν παιδεύοντός με καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” διδάσκοντός με οὐδὲ greek Meaning * Not * Nor * Neither * Not even A combination of the words οὐ (meaning no) and δέ (meaning however or but). The word οὐδέ adds another negative element to a sentence that already has one. οὐδέ can join words, phrases, or whole clauses. It often functions like English Matthew 6:20John 7:5Romans 3:10 παρέβαλλον τὸ greek Meaning: * The The definite article. Forms Singular Case Masculine Feminine Neuter Nominative ὁ ἡ τό Genitive τοῦ τῆς τοῦ Dative τῷ τῇ οὗς μου
KJV	And have not obeyed the voice of my teachers, nor inclined mine ear to them that instructed me!
