Hebrew	אֲשֶׁר אֵין לָהּ קָצִין שָׂר וּמַשְׁלָל
ESV	Without having any chief, officer, or ruler,
NIV	It has no commander, no overseer or ruler,
NLT	Though they have no prince or governor or ruler to make them work,
LXX	ἐκείνῳ γὰρ γεωργίου μὴ ὑπάρχοντος μηδὲ τὸν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek The definite article ἀναγκάζοντα ἔχων μηδὲ ὑπὸ δεσπότην ὦν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.
