LXX	ἀπὸ γὰρ θυρίδος ἐκ τοῦ greek The definite article οἴκου αὐτῆς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) εἰς τὰς greek The definite article πλατείας παρακύπτουσα
