

Proverbs 7:8

Hebrew	עֵבֶר בְּשׁוּק אֶצֶל פֶּנֶה וְדֶרֶךְ בֵּיתָהּ יֵצֵעַד
ESV	passing along the street near her corner, taking the road to her house
NIV	He was going down the street near her corner, walking along in the direction of her house
NLT	He was crossing the street near the house of an immoral woman, strolling down the path by her house.
LXX	παραπορευόμενον παρὰ γωνίαν ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. διόδοις οἴκων αὐτῆς greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
KJV	Passing through the street near her corner; and he went the way to her house,

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
