ESV	for my mouth will utter truth; wickedness is an abomination to my lips.
NIV	My mouth speaks what is true, for my lips detest wickedness.
NLT	for I speak the truth and detest every kind of deception.
LXX	ὅτι ἀλήθειαν μελετήσῃ ὁ greek The definite article φάρυγξ μου ἐβδελυγμένα δέ autotooltip_bigδέ greek δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἐναντίον ἐμοῦ χεῖλη ψευδῆ
