ESV	They are all straight to him who understands, and right to those who find knowledge.
NIV	To the discerning all of them are right; they are faultless to those who have knowledge.
NLT	My words are plain to anyone with understanding, clear to those with knowledge.
LXX	πάντα greek Meaning * All * Every * The whole Adjective. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ἐνώπια τοῖς greek The definite article συνοῦσιν καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ὁρθὰ τοῖς greek The definite article εὐρίσκουσι γινῶσιν
KJV	They are all plain to him that understandeth, and right to them that find knowledge.

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
