Hebrew	תֵּן לַחֲכָם וַיִּחְכֶּם עוֹד הוֹדַע לְצַדִּיק וַיִּוְסַף לָקָח
ESV	Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be still wiser; teach a righteous man, and he will increase in learning.
NIV	Instruct a wise man and he will be wiser still; teach a righteous man and he will add to his learning.
NLT	Instruct the wise, and they will be even wiser. Teach the righteous, and they will learn even more.

IT is most frequently translated as “and” σοφώτερος ἔσται plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
