The word בְּרָדָה marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope.Genesis 1:28Psalms 103:1Numbers 6:24
Hebrew	הִלָּח plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigהִלָּח hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word הִלָּח (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalms 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalms 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalms 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6
ESV	For the wicked boasts of the desires of his soul, and the one greedy for gain curses and renounces the LORD.
NIV	He boasts of the cravings of his heart; he blesses the greedy and reviles the LORD.
NLT	For they brag about their evil desires; they praise the greedy and curse the LORD.
