This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 בְּיֹדְךָ עָלָה גִּגְיָה
ESV	All the day my enemies taunt me; those who deride me use my name for a curse.
NIV	All day long my enemies taunt me; those who rail against me use my name as a curse.
NLT	My enemies taunt me day after day. They mock and curse me.
