Hebrew	הִתְהַלַּךְ לִיהוָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word הִתְהַלַּךְ (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. ESV	Oh give thanks to the LORD; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples!
NIV	Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done.
NLT	Give thanks to the LORD and proclaim his greatness. Let the whole world know what he has done.
