Hebrew	יהוה יהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 חסדו ונפלאותיו לבני אדם
ESV	Let them thank the LORD for his steadfast love, for his wondrous works to the children of men!
NIV	Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men,

Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. IT is most frequently translated as “and” τὰ greek The definite article θαυμάσια αὐτοῦ greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
