	The word הִיָּה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.
	This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.
	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 הִיָּה וְאֵל הִיָּה מִשְׁדֵּךְ תִּסְדֵּךְ וְאֵל הִיָּהplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big
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ESV	Let there be none to extend kindness to him, nor any to pity his fatherless children!
NIV	May no one extend kindness to him or take pity on his fatherless children.
NLT	Let no one be kind to him; let no one pity his fatherless children.
