ESV	May my accusers be clothed with dishonor; may they be wrapped in their own shame as in a cloak!
NIV	My accusers will be clothed with disgrace and wrapped in shame as in a cloak.
NLT	May my accusers be clothed with disgrace; may their humiliation cover them like a cloak.
LXX	ἐνδυσάσθωσαν οἱ greek The definite article ἐνδιαβάλλοντες με ἐντροπὴν καὶ autotooltip_bigκαί greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" περιβαλέσθωσαν ὥσεί διπλοῖδα αἰσχύνην αὐτῶν autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive).
