ESV	In return for my love they accuse me, but I give myself to prayer.
NIV	In return for my friendship they accuse me, but I am a man of prayer.
NLT	I love them, but they try to destroy me with accusations even as I am praying for them!

It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. προσευχόμεν
