	יְהוָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. ESV	The LORD tests the righteous, but his soul hates the wicked and the one who loves violence.
NIV	The LORD examines the righteous, but the wicked and those who love violence his soul hates.
